## CONFERENCE SESSIONS

### Morning Session

The first half of the day will cover current Inheritance Tax Planning Issues.

**Nick Holmes** and **Clive Beer** will provide delegates with an overview of current IHT relief and including the new main residence relief (effective from April 2017) and the opportunities/threats that arise from the new rules and the impact of ATED on succession planning. They will also look closely at the evidence base required for successful tax planning and proving APR and BPR applications, the valuation issues that arise, the importance of probate valuations and negotiation with the District Valuer/HMRC.

Our speakers will take delegates through various case studies and a 'behind the scenes' analysis of relevant tax cases.

This will provide delegates with up to date practical knowledge on a complex area of practice for all professions.

### Afternoon Session

Following lunch, we will focus on the way forward for a new UK Agricultural Policy following the referendum vote and the practical implications for Estate and Farm planning during the interim period whilst the UK negotiates its exit.

This will provide all delegates with the opportunity to take part in the debate and panel discussions which will follow an outline of the view of the current position and their take on the way forward from each of our panel of Experts, **Hugh Mercer QC, Julie Robinson, Andrew Fallows** and **Alex Carson-Taylor**.

The panel session will cover issues concerning the legal framework of the UK's exit, the opportunities and issues of international trade relations and the effect of the interim period during the UK's negotiation for the sale, purchase and letting of the land
